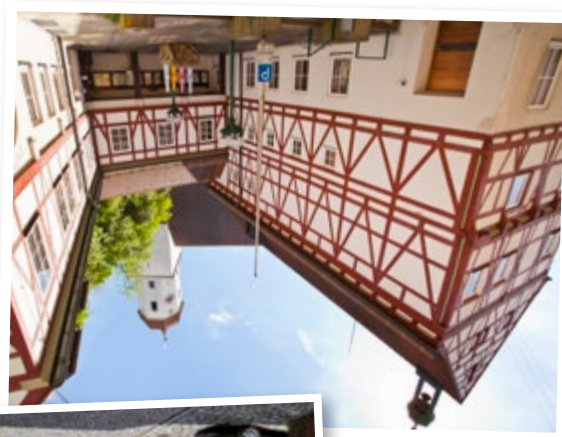

HISTORY & PURE NATURE

Top off your stay in Harburg by having a look at the „Plant Trail“ starting about 23 km away in Nördlingen and showing our planetary system in a scale of 1:430 million. In Harburg, at the end of this trail, on the hill called „Bock“ we find the „Pluto“ station. From here, you'll have a spectacular view of the Ries crater which was formed when a meteorite came down about 15 million of years ago. To learn more on this unique and fascinating phenomenon you can book a special guided tour.



HARBURG AN EXPERIENCE

Harburg can look back to a long history, as does the Castle which can be seen from afar towering over the town. But Harburg offers more than that and its romantic location on the banks of the river Wörnitz: the extensively renovated old stone bridge, the former synagoge dating back to 1754 (now privately owned), the marketplace with the „Moser Haus,“ the „Strölinhaus“ (now hosting the public library), the churches of „St. Barbara“ (protestant) and „Herz Jesu“ (catholic) as well as numerous picturesque corners!

If you have got an appetite now, the Harburg restaurateurs also offer you other traditional Bavarian dishes!



Harburg is closer than you think: Located on the famous Romantic Road, about 100 km north of Munich it lies right in the center of the Geopark Ries. Exactly between Nördlingen with its still preserved medieval wall surrounding the town and Donauwörth, the historic Imperial City.

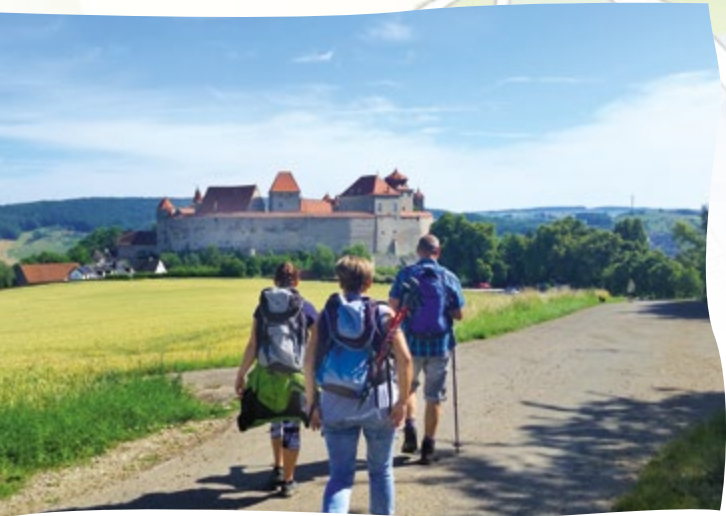
... the gateway to the Ries

HARBURG – AN EXPERIENCE



FANTASTIC VIEW & EXTENSIVE FORESTS

Our trails around Harburg starts at the „Oberer Burgparkplatz“ (parking space underneath the Castle) and leads us along a nice grass path to the former jewish cemetry and on top of the „Hühnerberg“. Walking through heathland, typical vegetation of the Ries, we reach „Pluto“ – the Harburg station of the Planet Trail. From here you have a spectacular view of the Ries Crater and of the valley of the river Wörnitz reaching till Donauwörth. We reach the summit cross on the „Bockberg“ hill, one of our natural monuments on the south-east border of the Ries crater. As we walk down through the forest we arrive at the

idyllic „Biergarten Eisbrunn“, a traditional restaurant surrounded by a romantic forest with numerous exotic trees. We walk back through the forest and along field tracks and eventually reach the entrance of our Harburg Castle – one of the best preserved castles in Southern Germany dating back to the time of the Staufer. You can stroll along the historical walls and have a look at some interesting exhibitions. To see the interior rooms and hear about the long story of the castle you should book one of the guided tours.



When back down in the center you can walk along our romantic alleys where you will find a lot of information on our historical buildings:
